KANDIA

This gorgeous girl is Kandia.

At the start of this year, she packed her bags and jetted off to her new home in the UK. It makes us so happy to see our ROLDA dogs receiving so much love and affection from their new forever families.





FLOPPY

Floppy was one of the first of our ROLDA dogs to be adopted this year! He's found his forever home with a lovely family in the UK. 2023 is Floppy's year – the year where he starts his second chance at life in a safe, loving environment, free from home.





TUPA

Tupa (now Lucky) is living her best life and we absolutely adore her.

She was completely house trained within a couple of days, she has made loads of new friends, and is really playful. She has been in the car to see the vet and, of course, to choose a new toy from the pet shop! She loves going to the local park and is really friendly with other dogs. She is truly amazing.





CHIPS

This defenseless dog was shot in his front paw, in the city of Kharkiv, Ukraine. We were relieved to know that rescue efforts done by our friend Robert, were successful in saving the dog's life.

He took the dog immediately to the vet clinic where he was examined, the wound was cleaned and he had a surgery to amputate the rest of his front leg. Chips has made a remarkable recovery and the wonderful news is that he will soon be traveling to his new family in Germany.







Kuzya was brought on December 29th from Kamyshevakhi, located near Zaporozhye, a place hit by constant shelling. His face speaks up for himself:

"I survived the war".

Kuzya is old, with multiple health issues including severe mange. His body was irritated and full of wounds from scratching, when he was found. People discovered him crying in a barn. His loud yelps guided people to rescue him. He was exhausted, couldn't even stand up, hungry, having an eye completely damaged and the other barely functional. From a dog shot with 3 bullets, abandoned to die in a barn ...Kuzya's life changed 360 degrees, due to love. At first Irina's love and the volunteers rescuers love. Then Kuzya met James, an US soldier whom impressed by his story, decided to adopt him. Fantastic life change for lucky Kuzya in a matter of weeks!





PINO

Pino was cruelly abandoned in the midst of freezing winter, left to fend for himself as a helpless 6 months-old kitten.

Luckily his cries for help were heard by his our friends from the Great Catsby association and he soon became part of our family of rescued babies.

Pino was started on FIP treatment as soon as he was diagnosed and a few long and difficult months are ahead of us.

Two month later, Pino, the brave FIP warrior is feeling much better.

At the moment he is enjoying life in his foster home, sleeping most of the day in cozy fluffy cat beds and running around with zoomies during the night, chasing his foster furry friends and hunting the feather toy like there's no tomorrow.





Driven by Love: How and Why ROLDA Began

ROLDA is a small, internationally supported charity that helps abused, neglected and unwanted animals in Romania through a responsible, efficient and humane approach. Our programs serve animals in need and pets with financially troubled owners, such as senior citizens, retirees and unemployed people.

VISION



MISSION

To build a world free from homeless, unwanted animals that suffer terribly on the streets.

A world where every dog and cat have the opportunity to form a strong, lifelong bond with their human companions.

To build humane and sustainable habitats for abused animals and to create safer, cleaner habitats to benefit the people in Romania.

Over the years, people have often asked me: "If you could be anyone in the world, who would you be?"

My name is Elena Daniela Costin, or Dana for short. I started ROLDA soon after I finished high school. During my 20s, the stray population boomed all over Romania, including in my hometown Galati. My first rescue dog was a German Shepherd, Printz, whom I found wounded and bloody. He was abandoned in a local park after an illegal dog fight. Printz was the first dog my parents allowed to stay in our tiny apartment! I have a story for most of the thousands animals helped by ROLDA after Printz.

WE HELP OTHER NEOS IN ROMANIA

The ROLDA Foundation is exclusively financed from donations and sponsorships; we receive no funding or special aid from the authorities.

Since its establishment, ROLDA has been backed by supporters from across the border who have maintained their efforts via the branches created in their countries to help us undergo our campaigns and programs, including adoptions, here.

Although we are still a tiny organization, we believe that the time has come for us to extend a helping hand to other NGOs in Romania that are in the process of setting up and that have met with difficulties on account of being at the beginning and inexperienced or having been severely affected by the current economic crisis.

HOW DOES ROLDA HELP OTHER ROMANIAN ORGANIZATIONS?

As of 2022, ROLDA has continued to support the Tulcea association, and we have extended our support to organizations in Caracal, Solca, Desa, and Focsani.

"Thank you from the bottom of our hearts, ROLDA, for the initiatives in our country and other areas! Thank you for the comfort and security offered through your campaigns to many suffering animals, creatures at the very end of the line!"

LULA'S PAW ASSOCIATION

"I had not heard of ROLDA before last year. It's when they donated many cans of cat food which I shared with my friends, the girls alongside whom I care for over 150 cats. Then the big surprise came when I started getting monthly help for the cases of cats and dogs we took in for operations and treatment. This is the first organization to volunteer its help by coming forward and saying – Hey! We want to help you... It was a breath of fresh air to get help when you least expect it. Even though I am not an organization with great resources and knowledge, my goal is to help animals, even at a lower level. But it is always good to help wherever you can."









Helping #UkraineAnimals



"Aleksey drives the ambulance around and rescues animals on the front line or during flooding. Despite two of his drivers previously being shot/killed by snipers, they managed to later make a sort of agreement to cease fire for men from his team who don't carry weapons and aggressive badges (as they called them), but a medical red badge (which both Aleksey and Toni had when we walk around) which means they are medical staff who go to rescue and not kill. (...) Remember I mentioned some birds singing? When they feel the bomb, they start flying randomly, desperate until it is quiet again. You know the bomb missed its target/you as soon as it is silent again... and you look around but what you see it's not Hell – it's life and hope."

Some thoughts written by Dana following her trip to Ukraine in June 2024

"When I reached the destination, Olena and her staff welcomed me. First, we unload the food and after emptying the car, she started to show me around, proudly presenting her work. Because Olena doesn't speak English and I don't speak Ukrainian, communication happened like this: One was speaking on the phone, an application translates her words in English which I read/or hear and I try to speak back, of course, application doesn't understand my English so I start writing which application translates into Ukrainian. This is how we communicated, it took longer but I could address my questions and Olena could explain a bit about herself and her organization.

At some point, I saw a coin on the floor. I opened Olena hand, put the coin on it and told her something that she will probably never forget: "Back home, I was told that every time you find a coin, you should pick it up because if you see it, if it's in your way, it means that someone from Heaven is thinking of you." I didn't knew about her life, but after learning her story, I am sure that the coin has a strong meaning for her. Why I am so sure? Read and will find out."



Dog corner



#FriendsForever was created by ROLDA to help seniors keep their pets healthy and prevent them from being forced to abandon the only friend they may have.

Many seniors in Romania live on the brink of crisis, in depression and poverty, often being forced to choose between buying medicines or paying utility bills.

Having a pet, for many, is the best thing that has happened to them. Older pet owners have often told us how incredibly lonely their lives were before their pet's companionship.

Started in January 2023, ROLDA's #FriendsForever campaign continues to support seniors who have a monthly income under 2,000 lei (approx 400 euro), by paying pet-related costs to ensure their needs are met.

JANUARY

Cornelia from Constanta – we helped her cover the vet costs for her dog Daisy, who has a chronic skin disorder. Cornelia has 3 more dogs in her care.





FEBRUARY

Valeria from Bucharest – ROLDA helped to pay for the surgery of the right back leg of her dog Rita, who was diagnosed with coxofemoral subluxation and a patellar bilateral luxation degree IV, on her back legs. In 6 weeks Rita will also need to the left leg operated on.

MARCH

When the first surgery to fix Hera's leg failed, Iulia was devastated. Hera couldn't use the leg at all and the pain was excruciating. Iulia lives in Bucharest where there are plenty of vet clinics she could go to for a second opinion, but with such a small pension she couldn't afford to pay for surgery, so Hera faced a painful life. ROLDA paid for the surgery and Hera's leg has been fixed, she is now recovering nicely.





APRIL

Anisoara is a widow with a very small pension and 3 pekinese in her care. She can barely cover the costs for the utilities and the food for herself and the dogs. One of the 3 dogs is very old and suffers from glaucoma and urinary incontinence and in March ROLDA helped Anisoara buy diapers. Sadly, her condition



started to deteriorate, she was waking in the night a lot and crying and she also started to go round in circles.

We helped her investigate further and the vets discovered a brain tumor. It couldn't be operated on at such an advanced age, and since her pain was so bad, Anisoara had to make the very hard choice to put her beloved pet to sleep.

MAY

Antoaneta lives in Caracal and has always loved animals. She has 3 dogs that she saved from the streets of Caracal: senior Linda, Rocky the German Shephard and Mingiuta. She also has 7 cats. Her income is very, very low and it's really hard to buy food, flea prevention treatment, and vaccinate all 10 pets in her care.



Despite this, she loves them to the moon and back and will do everything in her power for them. With ROLDA's support, this month she vaccinated and microchipped all her pets and we are very glad we could help!

JUNE





Lidia has 4 dogs and 5 cats. Her husband died last year and on her small monthly income she could no longer afford to pay for her medication (she suffers from diabetes and a special form of depression) or her pets medicines. Her dog Bella has heart worms and will need regular monthly treatments; her other dog has mange and needed to be treated for that too; and these are only a few of the problems they face. Lidia was very happy that, thanks to ROLDA, all the dogs received internal and external parasite treatment, Bella received her heart treatment, and we also bought dry food for all her dogs and cats.

JULY

Mrs. Marioara and her husband have rescued 70 stray dogs over the years.

Their income is very, very low and they can barely cover the food costs, especially as kibbles are getting more and more expensive.

They asked for our help in covering the costs of 12 flea and tick prevention treatments.



AUGUST

Mrs. Gaby lives on the outskirts of the city and takes care of 15 dogs and more than 10 cats on the field near her house. She recently rescued 2 more cats that were abandoned, one was already sterilized and for the other she needed our help for sterilizing her and also for the flee & tick external treatment. ROLDA also bought her food for the dogs she is caring for.





SEPTEMBER





Mrs. Lucica is from Scornicesti and a few weeks ago 7 cats were thrown over her fence, in the yard. Since she had other rescued kittens with panleukopenia she asked our help to urgently vaccinate all 7, to keep them healthy and avoid other problems and expenses. The cats will be also sterilized with our support.

OCTOBER



Mrs. Gabriela had a very difficult surgery and all the money she had were spent for medicines and other costs related to it. Her dogs were out of food and we made arrangements for having it delivered to her house. This is the message she sent us: "Hooray, today the little one will eat their fill. Thank you very much ROLDA, I wish you good health and all the best."

November

Mr. Cristi is the owner of sweet Daisy. She was hit by a car and her back legs were damaged: the left leg was broken in 2 parts and the right one was also hurt. Thanks to our help Daisy had the surgery and the left leg was fixed with a metal rod. She is now slowly recovering and each day she feels better and better. Without us, her surgery could not be done.



December



Mrs. Lidia has 3 dogs, each of them with a different health issue: Pusica has kidney problems, Belluta has heart issues, both of them needing daily treatment, and the third one started losing the fur on his back, he needed to have a dermatological examination and than he received treatment. Mrs. Lidia could not have covered the vet bills without our help and we hope the three sweeties can live many more years loved and well cared by her.





Norway: 0.3%




